### NEW SERVICE OFFERINGS

#### Telemedicine Program

In 2009, Baylor Waxahachie became the first hospital in the Metroplex to implement the use of a robot that allows specialists from Baylor Dallas to conduct pulmonary and critical care consults in Baylor Waxahachie's ICU. Baylor Waxahachie continued the expansion of the telemedicine program when it began its stroke care program, bringing emergent stroke care to Waxahachie for the first time ever.

#### Emergency Care Services

Baylor Waxahachie wants to be your health care resource for your emergent and routine health care needs. In order to serve our patients better, Baylor Waxahachie recently completed the expansion of the Emergency Department. Part of that expansion included an area to facilitate minor emergency care. Patients with minor emergencies can now be seen and released in about an hour on average.

## BAYLOR WAXAHACHIE'S GROWING INVESTMENT IN OUR COMMUNITY

- In fiscal year 2011, Baylor Waxahachie provided \$7.44 million in charity care to the community.
- Every year, Baylor Waxahachie continues to make a substantial donation to the Hope Clinic, a faith based outpatient clinic for the uninsured or underinsured in Ellis County.
- Approximately 4,400 children received vaccines through our free monthly immunization clinic.
- In fiscal year 2011, approximately 4,000 people took advantage of a community health education event or health fair screening on an annual basis.
- Baylor Waxahachie supports fellow community non-profit organizations such as Waxahachie ISD Education Foundation, Pink Ribbons and Hearts and American Cancer Society by contributing to annual fund raising events.
- The Auxiliary at Baylor Waxahachie consist of over 170 volunteers that donate thousands of hours of their time and effort each year to Baylor. Their efforts have raised over \$690,000 in the last six years for scholarships and patient care projects for the hospital.
