



FROM NORTH DALLAS HWY 75

- South on Hwy 75
- Exit Haskell
- Turn left on Haskell
- Turn right at Worth Street to Valet park
- Self-parking is available in the underground garage accessible from Crutcher Street

FROM NORTH DALLAS – TOLLWAY

- Take the tollway south and continue until the sign for Pearl Street (on the left)
- Take Pearl Street exit (left) & continue through approximately 12 traffic lights
- Turn left at Pacific Street (which will change into Gaston Avenue)
- Pacific Street will change into Gaston Avenue after you go under Central Expressway
- Turn right at Hall Street
- Turn left at Worth Street to Valet park
- Self-parking is available in the underground garage accessible from Crutcher Street

FROM DALLAS I-35

- I-35 to downtown interchange & exit I-30 East
- Exit Carroll, Peak & Haskell
- Turn left onto Peak
- Turn left at Worth Street to Valet park
- Self-parking is available in the underground garage accessible from Crutcher Street

FROM SOUTH DALLAS I-45 & I-75

- Take I-30 East
- Exit Carroll, Peak & Haskell
- Turn left onto Peak
- Turn left at Worth Street to Valet park
- Self-parking is available in the underground garage accessible from Crutcher Street

FROM WEST DALLAS I-30

- I-30 East
- Exit Carroll, Peak & Haskell
- Turn left onto Peak
- Turn left at Worth Street to Valet park
- Self-parking is available in the underground garage accessible from Crutcher Street

FROM EAST DALLAS I-30

- Take I-30 West
- Exit Carroll/Peak
- Turn right onto Peak
- Turn left at Worth Street to Valet park
- Self-parking is available in the underground garage accessible from Crutcher Street

PARKING PROVIDED BY BAYLOR:

- V Valet Parking** - circle drive in front of the future dedicated cancer hospital/Worth Street Tower; entrance on Worth St.
- P Self-parking** - Garage 4, entrances on Worth St. and Junius St.; exit on Worth St.; take garage elevator to 3rd floor to skybridge

PARKING PROVIDED BY LAZ:

- V Valet Parking** - circle drive in front of the outpatient cancer center; entrance on Worth St.
- P Self-parking** - garage underneath the outpatient cancer center, accessible from Crutcher Street

Parking Options - Provided by LAZ


- V** Valet parking circle drive accessible from Worth Street:
 - Per Use \$10

- P** Self-parking in the underground garage of the new outpatient cancer center accessible from Crutcher Street.
 - 0-1 hour \$2
 - 1-3 hours \$4
 - 3-4 hours \$6
 - Daily Max \$8

- D** Patient drop-off locations:
 - Valet circle drive in front of the outpatient cancer center accessible from Worth Street.
 - Circle drive area at the back of the outpatient cancer center accessible from Crutcher Street.

Parking Options - Provided by Baylor University Medical Center at Dallas

The existing parking options remain accessible from Worth Street across from the new outpatient cancer center:

-  A skybridge is accessible on the 3rd floor in garage 4 and Worth Street Tower.

- V** Valet drive in front of Worth Street Tower and Baylor Cancer Hospital (under construction). For patients needing extra help, a golf cart may be available to transport you to the new cancer center.
 - Per use \$5

- P** Self-parking in garage 4; a skybridge is accessible on the 3rd floor in garage 4.
 - Daily rate \$4
 - Package of 5 vouchers . . \$10

- D** Patient drop-off locations:
 - Valet drive in front of Worth Street Tower and Baylor Cancer Hospital (under construction).
 - Valet circle drive in front of the outpatient cancer center accessible from Worth Street.
 - Circle drive area at the back of the outpatient cancer center accessible from Crutcher Street.

**Sets of 5 parking vouchers are available for \$10. They may be purchased in Ernie's Appearance Center in Suite 210 or at the Wadley/Barnett Tower valet area or at the Baylor parking services office at 4005 Crutcher Street, Suite 160.
