

**BAYLOR INSTITUTE FOR REHABILITATION MAKES
'BEST PLACES TO WORK' LIST FOR 4TH CONSECUTIVE YEAR**

Baylor Institute for Rehabilitation once again made the *Dallas Business Journal's (DBJ)* list of "Best Places to Work in North Texas" by placing #6 in the "Extra Large Company" category. The recognition was announced by the *DBJ* at its annual luncheon held at the Fairmont Hotel in Dallas, with independent research firm Quantum Workplace compiling the results. Quantum surveyed employees from each company, compiled data, tallied results and then matched the results against national standards to select the winners.
