

Baylor Medical Center at Carrollton is a 235-bed acute care facility located at 4343 North Josey Lane in Carrollton. Initially established as Trinity Medical Center in 1985, the hospital became part of the Baylor Health Care System network of hospitals in June 2009. Baylor Carrollton provides a broad spectrum of medical and health care services to the people of North Dallas. The medical staff is comprised of over 500 physicians representing more than 50 specialties. Baylor Carrollton is a full service hospital providing comprehensive diagnostic, surgical, and medical care for inpatients and outpatients, as well as 24-hour emergency care. The hospital's emergency department is designated as an accredited chest pain center. Baylor Carrollton is accredited by the Joint Commission, the nation's oldest and largest hospital accreditation agency.

WOMEN'S SERVICES

Providing quality health care to women is one of Baylor Carrollton's specialties. No matter what stage of a woman's life, Baylor Carrollton offers a wide range of services to help women maintain good health. A full service maternity program includes home-like LDRs (labor/delivery/recovery rooms), surgical delivery suites, a 28-bed newborn nursery and a 15-bed neonatal intensive care nursery, equipped to care for infants as early as 27 weeks gestation. The hospital's comprehensive program also includes diagnostic, medical and therapeutic services such as screening and diagnostic mammograms, bone densitometry screening for osteoporosis, diagnostic testing and treatment for incontinence, gynecologic services, as well as geriatric services through the Senior Health Center. Located just north of the hospital on Josey Lane, the Women's Imaging Center offers a full range of breast screening and diagnostic services—mammog-

raphy, breast ultrasound, and stereotactic biopsy – along with on-site breast imaging specialists and breast surgeons on the medical staff.

FERTILITY SERVICES

Baylor Carrollton's goal is to find the most appropriate option for couples needing infertility consultation. Board-certified gynecologists and reproductive endocrinologists on the medical staff trained in in-vitro fertilization (IVF) procedures and other assisted reproduction techniques offer advanced technology to couples seeking fertility assistance. An on-campus IVF lab is accredited by the College of American Pathologists. Embryo and sperm cryopreservation and storage are also available.

ORTHOPEDICS

Baylor Medical Center at Carrollton has advanced capabilities in the treatment of orthopedic injuries and illnesses. Orthopedic services include: total joint replacement - including hips, knees and shoulders, a joint wellness program designed to help patients quickly return to their normal lives after joint replacement surgery and the use of minimally invasive techniques for hips, knees and shoulders, complex joint reconstruction, comprehensive sports medicine services, as well as inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation.

VASCULAR SERVICES

Baylor Carrollton's new interventional and vascular radiology suite provides an alternative to surgery using minimally invasive procedures to treat a wide range of clinical problems including stroke, carotid artery disease, abdominal aortic aneurysms and other peripheral vascular disorders. Among the many benefits of catheter-based interventions are shorter hospital stays, reduced recovery time without the pain of a large incision, and less visible surgical scarring.

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WEIGHT LOSS SURGERY

The weight loss surgery program at Baylor Carrollton has been recognized as a Center of Excellence by the American Society of Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery (ASMBS). The program has also been named a Blue Distinction Center for Bariatric Surgery® by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas*, an Aetna Institute of Quality for Bariatric Surgery, a Cigna-Certified hospital for Bariatric Surgery, and an OptumHealth Bariatric Surgery Center of Excellence by United Healthcare. Bariatric surgeons on the medical staff offer individualized weight loss surgery options designed to promote long-term weight management for those struggling with obesity. The goal of surgery for morbid obesity is to help the patient modify his or her behavior so that with a proper diet and exercise, successful and lasting weight loss may be achieved.

WOUND CARE CENTER

The Wound Care Center at Baylor Carrollton is equipped to handle all the unique circumstances of chronic non-healing wounds. The team first will determine the specific causes of a wound and then create a personalized plan for healing. Advanced treatment methods include: Enterstomal therapy, Doppler evaluation, the use of bio-engineered tissue substitutes, hyperbaric oxygen therapy, negative pressure wound therapy (Wound VAC), transcutaneous oxygen monitoring, general wound care and debridement, physical therapy, diabetes counseling and pain management. The center will also work with the patient's physician to arrange follow-up care for related health conditions. One of the newest forms of medicine today, Hyperbaric Oxygen (HBO) therapy causes a 10-to-15 fold increase in plasma oxygen concentration, resulting in increased tissue oxygenation and faster healing.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Collaborating with the community through proactive health care initiatives helps Baylor Carrollton achieve Baylor Health Care System's mission. Baylor Carrollton provides health fairs, presentation, screenings, outreach programs, supplies to area school districts, chambers of commerce, churches, employers and civic organizations. For fiscal year 2010, Baylor Medical Center at Carrollton reported \$17,393,832* in community benefit, which includes providing care for charity patients and patients enrolled in government programs such as Medicare and Medicaid, as well as the unreimbursed costs of medical education, research and community programs.

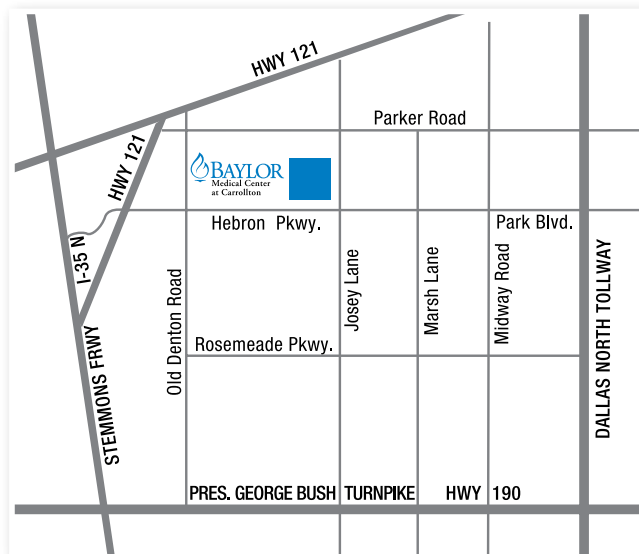
