Baylor Medical Center at Garland

Baylor Medical Center at Garland is a fully accredited, 240-bed medical center serving the residents of Garland, Texas, and the neighboring communities of Wylie, Rowlett, Sachse, Mesquite and Murphy.

Baylor Garland – part of Baylor Health Care System – provides advanced medical care in a healing, supportive environment. Recognized for comprehensive services in heart and vascular care, diagnostic and interventional imaging, women’s services, neonatal intensive care, sleep medicine, digestive disease, family medicine, and physical medicine and rehabilitation, Baylor Garland has 582 physicians on its medical staff representing a wide range of specialties.

HIGHLIGHTS

Emergency Department

In summer 2010, Baylor Garland completed a \$10.5 million, 4,300-square-foot expansion and renovation of the Emergency Department (ED). The Baylor Garland ED now offers a dedicated ambulance entrance, eight medical screening exam rooms, new lobby, check-in and waiting areas, 20 treatment rooms and seven critical care rooms. Laboratory and pharmacy services, as well as expanded radiology capabilities, have been added.

Heart and Vascular Care

Baylor Garland provides quality heart and vascular services, including diagnostic, interventional, surgical and rehabilitation services. From vascular surgery and pacemaker implantation to coronary artery bypass surgery, patients benefit from sophisticated equipment and advanced procedures performed by highly skilled staff consisting of physicians, nurses and techs. In 2011, the Society of Chest Pain Centers awarded Baylor Garland Chest Pain Center and Heart Failure Center Accreditation based on rigorous quality measures that improve heart failure and chest pain care.

Women’s Health

The Women’s Center at Baylor Garland is where moms-to-be deliver their babies in spacious labor/delivery/recovery rooms, each equipped with advanced technology. A neonatal intensive care unit provides care for infants as young as 28 weeks gestation. Perinatologists on the medical staff provide care for women with high-risk pregnancies. Baylor Garland also offers genetic counseling and newborn testing to screen for approximately 30 inherited metabolic diseases. Baylor Garland also offers comprehensive, specialized health care for every stage of a woman’s life, including gynecological, breast and menopausal/aging issues.

Sleep Center

Lack of sleep or poor quality sleep can lead to many health problems. At the Baylor Garland Sleep Center, located on the fifth floor of the medical center, patients undergo comprehensive evaluation and treatment for numerous sleep disorders, including sleep apnea, restless legs syndrome, periodic limb movement syndrome, narcolepsy, sleep terrors, REM sleep behavioral disorders and insomnia.

Baylor Centers for Pain Management

The Baylor Centers for Pain Management in Richardson and Wylie offer patients access to advanced pain management techniques, specialized medical staff and customized programs. Based on a comprehensive evaluation, pain management physicians develop a customized approach to accelerate a return to normal daily activities. The interdisciplinary staff includes physicians on the medical staff specializing in pain management, physical and occupational therapists and case managers.

Digestive Disease Center

Baylor Garland offers comprehensive care for digestive diseases and disorders in our Digestive Disease Center located on the medical center's fifth floor. The center is dedicated to the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of digestive disorders and diseases, including colon cancer, peptic ulcer disease and gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD). The center has five procedure rooms, a fluoroscopy room for imaging, and a spacious, comfortable waiting area.

Rehabilitation Services

Baylor Garland's 24-bed inpatient rehabilitation unit features a multidisciplinary team of professionals who work with patients to overcome musculoskeletal and neurological deficits resulting from injury or disease, such as arthritis, spinal injury, repetitive-motion injury and stroke. Outpatient rehabilitation services are also available on the Baylor Garland campus. Services range from occupational and physical therapy to sports injury rehabilitation and hand therapy.

Breast Services

Baylor Breast Center's clinical staff offers screening and diagnostic digital mammography services, bone density testing, stereotactic breast biopsies and ultrasound-guided procedures. Faster and more efficient than traditional film mammography, digital mammography allows clinicians to obtain crisper images, which is especially important for younger women who have dense breast tissue or for women of any age with fibrocystic breasts. The center's care team includes certified mammography technologists, radiologists and breast surgeons on the medical staff of Baylor Garland. Breast imaging services are also available at Baylor Diagnostic Imaging Center at Mesquite.

Comprehensive Wound Center

The Comprehensive Wound Center, located on the Baylor Garland campus, concentrates on providing comprehensive, advanced treatment for chronic, non-healing wounds. The center's medical staff identifies the specific causes of a wound condition and implements a treatment plan tailored to heal this area. To provide optimal care, a team approach, using medical specialties including general and vascular surgeons, foot and ankle surgeons, infectious disease specialists, physiatrists and internists, collaborate to speed healing.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

As part of its Christian ministry of healing, community service is a cornerstone of Baylor Garland's mission. From offering clinically based programs such as health screenings and support groups to building relationships with nonprofit organizations, Baylor Garland is committed to making life better for the residents of North Texas.
